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RANGPUR AT A GLANCE

Rangpur is one of Bangladesh's eight divisions, with its headquarters at Rangpur Sadar. It is located in the northern region of Bangladesh. The river Teesta runs beside Rangpur, which is home to a vast irrigation barrage. Prime Medical College is a 30 kilometers drive from the nearest airport, which is located at Saidpur. Rangpur is also well connected by road and air to Kolkata, Kathmandu, and Thimphu. The city is one of the oldest in the country's northern area.

Rangpur is a place of old heritage, culture, and history. Raja Janoki Ballov, the Jamindar of Dimla, Rangpur, encouraged health awareness in the area by diggingan 8-kilometer sewage canal in memory of his mother, Shyama Sundori. This Shyama Sunduri canal was constructed in 1857 with Sir Steuart Colvin Bayley's help to connect the two sides of the river Ghagat.

Begum Rokeya (1880-1932), a renowned educationist was born in this region. Her enormous contributions still encourage women in the country to pursue education, and this made her a pioneer in female education in Bangladesh.

Rangpur, which is located in the northern region of the country and is considerably closer to the Himalayas, has a low temperature of 5 to 6 degrees Celsius in the winter and a high of 32 to 35 degrees in the summer. With the taste of the country's six seasons, the climate remains pleasant in Rangpur throughout the year.





Imparting medical education leading to a recognized medical degree is the first and foremost aim to establish the Prime Medical College. The Prime Medical College started functioning from 2008-2009 session with 50 students. The college got affiliated with Rajshahi University to the completion on 1st November 2010. Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BMDC) recognized the college on 6th June 2010. The 1st Professional MBBS Examination under Rajshahi University was held in July 2010 after completing two years of prescribed course of studies. Currently, the 16th Batch of the students is studying in the college. The Ministry of Health and Rajshahi Medical University were pleased with the academic performance of the institute and allowed to increase the seat capacity from 50 to 135. Now the college has a new 7 storied academic building with 40,000sq.feet floor space in each floor with adequate parking facilities. All the departments are setup on its own premises including the college building with tutorial class rooms, laboratories, museum, office rooms, library, conference room & lecture galleries. The attached hospital (PMCH) is a tertiary care referral medical facility and provides excellent training to students, junior doctors and paramedics. The Hospital has the capacity of 750 beds. It is well equipped and provides quality health care to the public at a reasonable cost. The entire hospital staff are dedicated to excellence and service.

FACILITIES AVAILABLE IN THE COLLEGE

COLLEGE ACCOMMODATION



Prime Medical College is a seven storied building. All the administrative and academic activities are goes on here. This is a very spacious building with a modern structural design. All the modern facilities of an ideal medical educational institute are available. The outlook of the college building is very beautiful. Every floor has a capacity of approximately 40,000 sq. feet. There are an adequate number of teachers and other staff in this college. At present, the college has the capacity of teaching about 150 students per year.





There are 4 large fully air-conditioned galleries with multimedia and a digital sound system for lectures. In addition, there are tutorial rooms and practical class rooms attached to the respective departments. The Anatomy dissection hall has sufficient cadavers for dissection. The laboratories of various departments like Biochemistry, Physiology, Pathology, Microbiology, Pharmacology, and museums of concern departments - Anatomy, Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, Community



Medicine & PuCbOlicM health andM Pathology are well equipped.



There are two common rooms for students (One for males and one for females) with television, WIFI, daily newspaper and lots of indoor games.

TEACHING METHODS



Teaching is provided through lectures, demonstrations, tutorials, ward clinics, practical classes, field visits, study tours, and surveys on health problems. Monthly clinical meetings are held on a regular basis. Teaching aids such as overhead projectors, slide projectors, multimedia projectors, and computers with teaching CDs are used in the teaching of learning procedures.





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MEU has modern computers, printers, scanners photocopier machine Internet and e-mail facilities. The computers are freely available to the students. Quality Assurance Meeting, CME Training Organize Journal Committee Meeting, Research Protocol Training, Refresher Course training, Workshop, Question Moderation Training of New Teacher, Integrated Teaching Departmental morning session, seminar for Teacher organised by MEU. All Teacher of this Institute are Trained under CME.



CAREER COUNSELING UNIT

PMC Career Unit focuses on providing guidance, motivation and support to students regarding their academic and professional pathways. This unit assist to the students in understanding their interests, skills and aspirations & aligning them with suitable career options.





There are facilities for extra-curricular activities like Indoor/ outdoor games, cultural programs, free blood donation camp, eyesight test, free donation of medicine for poor people, distribution of winter clothes, observation of national & International days, etc. Students publish wallpapers and annual magazine. Debates, seminars, and cultural events are held regularly. The college also publishes its own internationally recognized medical journal. College has arranged the annual Sports and Cultural Week regularly from 2013. Total 50 events organized annually. More than 150 prizes given among 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners.



ACADEMIC AWARD



Every year Prime Medical College are given Academic awards and prize money to students who place 1st, 2nd and 3rd in their professional exams. It recognizes the hardwork, dedication and academic excellence of students throughout their medical education. As a result, competitive spirit is created among the students and good results are achieved.





COLLEGE CAFETERI

There is a large and modern cafeteria at the college campus facilitated with quality foods and beverages for students & teachers according to their religious views and preferences.





The college has Micro-buses, mini-buses, buses for student transport, eld visit, and recreation visit.



The College has its own eet of transport which can be used on a payment basis by the group of students both foreign and local for outside sightseeing visits, picnics, pleasure trips, etc. on the weekend with permission of the college authority.





Prime Medical College Hospital provides special treatment facilities to students, intern doctors and their parents. Students & intern doctors get cabin/general beds, OPD & other procedures, ambulance service without paying any charge. Their parents and other relatives also gets other facilities at minimum of cost.



AUDITORIUM



Auditorium with a seating capacity 1500 Persons, which is situated at the top floor. There are adequate spaces for cooking and refreshment attached to the auditorium. It is used for cultural and co-curricular activities, seminars, workshops, etc.



HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION



Prime Medical College campus has complete residential facilities for all MBBS students, intern doctors and resident doctors. There are four hostels. three for males (students & intern doctors)total seat capacity 360 & one for females(students & intern doctors) total seat capacity 367. Residential facilities like separate earmarked block, single, double, and triple bedded room for student and table, chair, cupboard, 24 hours supply of water, electricity & laundry services are available. There are several kitchens (Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian) to prepare the foods with considering the religious views. Hostel common room has the facilities like Lift, T.V. with cables connection and indoor games.







The College has a fully air-conditioned library provided about 3292 latest edition text books and 1518 local & foreign journals on various subjects. Library has Teachers Reading Area, Student Reading Area, Career Counseling Reading Corner Library Book & Journal Self, IT Corner & Newspaper Corner. World renowned journal Lancet, JAMA, BMJ also registered here. The library provides updated Medical information to students and teachers. The library reading room can accommodate about 450 students at a time. Students and teachers can also take text books for use at home. Wi-Fi internet connection has been provided in the library so that students can browse and download recent scientific materials. The library remains open 7 days a week from 8.00 am to 9.30 pm. There is also the scope of having photocopies and all other learning facilities available in the library.



CONFERENCE ROOM



There is a fully air-conditioned well-decorated conference room having arrangement of sitting of 150 people. This is located in the ground floor of the college building.



Academic Council and Guardians Advisory Committee hold meetings when necessary. They discuss all the aspects of academic matters of the college and suggest measures for improving the academic environment and total improvement of teaching in the college.



Guardians' advice on college a airs is always encouraged. There is a Guardians Advisory Committee, which holds yearly meetings. Two representatives of guardians are included in the Governing Body. Guardians are communicated regularly about their children's academic performance and class attendance. They are often invited to put forward suggestions on how to improve the performance of the students. The Members of the Committee are selected annually from the guardians of the students.







ADMISSION PROCEDURE FORFOREIGN STUDENTS

At present, 135 Students get admission in each academic session. The Government of Bangladesh has permitted for admission of 45% of foreign students from 2014-2015 academic session. At present there are 733 students in five batches among them 260 students are foreigners.

ELIGIBILITY FOR

FOREIGN STUDENTS

To get selection in MBBS course foreign students must pass the SSC/SLC/O - Level/GCSE or equivalent examination consisting minimum of 5 subjects acquiring a minimum average GPA-3.00. Also pass in HSC/A-level/12-grade or equivalent examination with Biology, Chemistry & Physics and average securing mark minimum GPA 3.00 but Minimum aggregate GPA in SSC/SLC/O-level/GCSE and HSC/A-level/12-grade or equivalent examination should be 7.00 (seven) and must have to pass Biology with GPA 3.50.

All foreign applicants must have to apply through online to the website of Directorate General of Medical Education of The Government of Bangladesh. Students get their equivalence certificate applying through the Bangladeshi Embassy. All certificates/ mark-sheets/other certificates and passport photocopy are to be attested by respected country's Education Board or Ministry of Education and authenticated by the respective country's foreign ministry. Total expenses for 5 years MBBS Course: US\$ 45,000.00 (excluding Hostel and Food).



SPECIAL POLICIES

Students will state their problems/ grievances/ inconvenience to their designated guide teacher/supervisor teacher/phase counselor/subject coordinator/phase coordinator & academic coordinator who will solve the problems of the students or will refer them to the principal.

At the time of admission to the college, students and parents/ guardians will have to sign a bond that their children will abide by the rules and regulations of the college.

Every student shall provide for himself/herself all the prescribed text books, dissecting instruments, and medical equipment.

RE-ADMISSION POLICY

A Student may be expelled/suspended from the college register under the following circumstances. He/She may be re-admitted after solving/explaining the accusations madeby the college authority or as per the decision of the academic council by paying a fee of taka 20,000.00.

- a. Remaining absent from classes for more than four weeks without any notification.
- b. Non-payment of college dues like tuition fee, session fee, development fee, etc (within three months of the due date of payment).
- c. Disciplinary ground, on the advice of the academic council.

TUITION AND OTHER FEES

Tuition fee / Hostel fees are payable within 15th day of the schedule month, in case of failure to pay in specified time a fine of taka 10.00 (Ten) per day will be charged. Installment for any kind of fees, fixed / offered by college authority must be paid within the schedule month as per contract. In case of failure a fine of taka 50.00 (Fifty) per day will be charged. If any student fails to pay tuition fee for a total of three (03) months or more his name will be erased from college register. The student will then have to seek re-admission on payment of full arrear dues and re-admission

ATTENDANCE POLICY

.Students possessing attendance of less than 75% of total class held will not be considered eligible to participate in any card, term and professional examinations under university. Abstinence from class either lecture or tutorial / practical / clinical will be charged taka 25.00 (Twenty-five) as fine against each class. Students having overall 75% attendance will be exempted from such type of penalty. Student if remain absent for more than four weeks without prior approval from competent authority may be stuck out from attendance register. A sum of taka 20,000.00 (twenty thousand) will be charged as a fee for readmission. In case of absence / Leave due to illness or other unavoidable reasons, a written application through proper channel mentioning the reasonable/valid causes should be place to the principal for final approval.

MIGRATION POLICY

Migration from Prime Medical College to another college as per DGME rules.

PUNISHMENTS

These are considered as acts of indiscipline and the offenders involved are liable for punishment. On disciplinary grounds the following penalties may be imposed on a student, depending on the nature of the offense. Penalty/penalties imposed on a student will be recorded in his/her Transcript/ Testimonial. a. Warning, b. Fines, c. Suspension from college classes, d. Expulsion from the college, temporarily or permanently, e. The cost of loss/damage to college/hospital property is liable to be realized by the student who is found to be responsible for the loss/damage of the college/hospital property, f. The authority reserves the right of cancelling the admission of a student who fails to show any satisfactory improvement after receiving three warning letters.

INTERNATIONAL CODE OF MEDICAL ETHICS

The International Code of Medical Ethics, as adopted by the World Medical Association of London, in October 1949 are stated below: Duties of Doctors in General:

- A doctor must always maintain the highest standards of professional conduct
- A doctor must not allow himself or herself to be influenced merely by motives of profit

THE FOLLOWING PRACTICES **ARE DEEMED UNETHICAL**

- Any self advertisement except such as is expressly authorised by the national code of medical ethics
- Taking part in any plan of medical care in which the doctor does not have professional independence
- Receiving any money in connection with services rendered to a patient other than the acceptance of a proper professional fee

Under no circumstances a doctor is permitted to do anything that would weaken the physical or mental resistance of a human being except from strictly therapeutic or prophylactic indications imposed in the interest of the patient. A doctor is advised to use great caution in publishing discoveries. The same applies to methods of treatment whose value is not recognized by the profession. When a doctor is called upon to give evidence or a certificate he should only state that which he or she can verify.





DECLARATION OF GENEVA

The World Medical Association in Geneva adopted in September, 1948 the following declaration which is intended to be Sworn when a doctor is admitted as a member of medical profession:

- I solemnly pledge myself to consecrate my life to the service of humanity
- I will give to my teachers the respect and gratitude which is their due
- I will practice my profession with conscience and dignity.
- The health of my patient will be my first consideration
- I will respect the secrets which are confided in me
- I will maintain by all the means the honour and noble tradition of the medical profession
- My colleagues will be my brother
- I will not permit considerations of religion, nationality, race, party politics or social standing to intervene between my duty and my patient
- I will maintain the utmost respect for human life from the time of conception
- Even under threat I will not use my medical knowledge contrary to the laws of humanity
- I make these promises solemnly, freely and upon my honour
